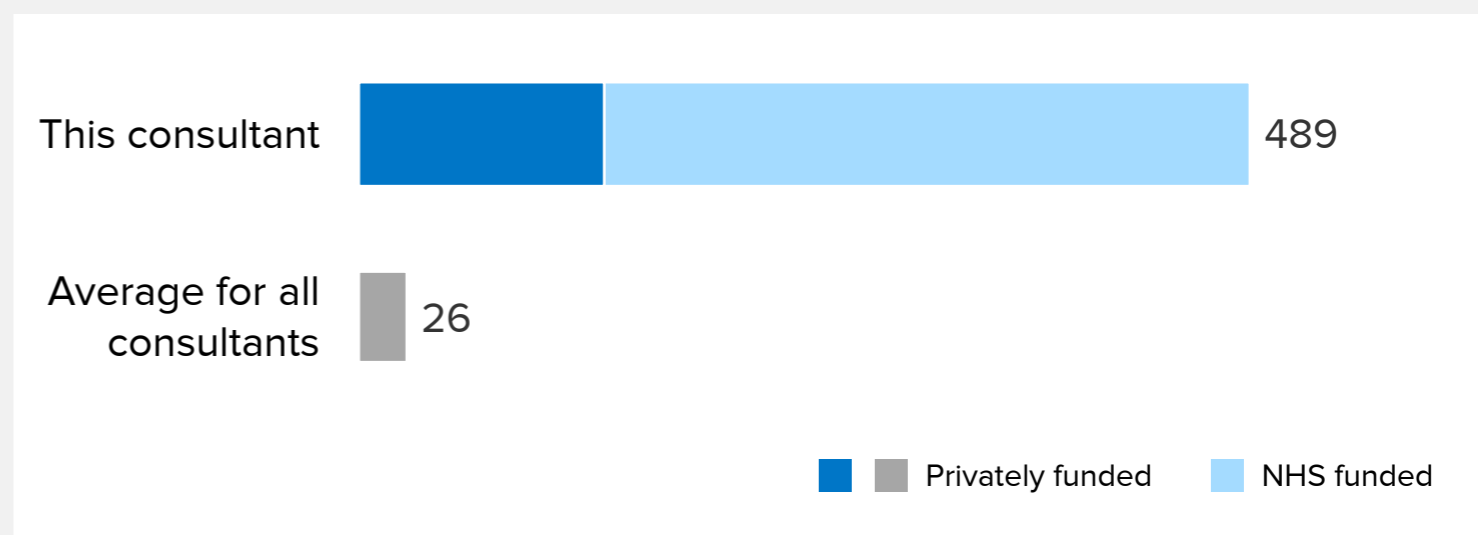

### Patient numbers

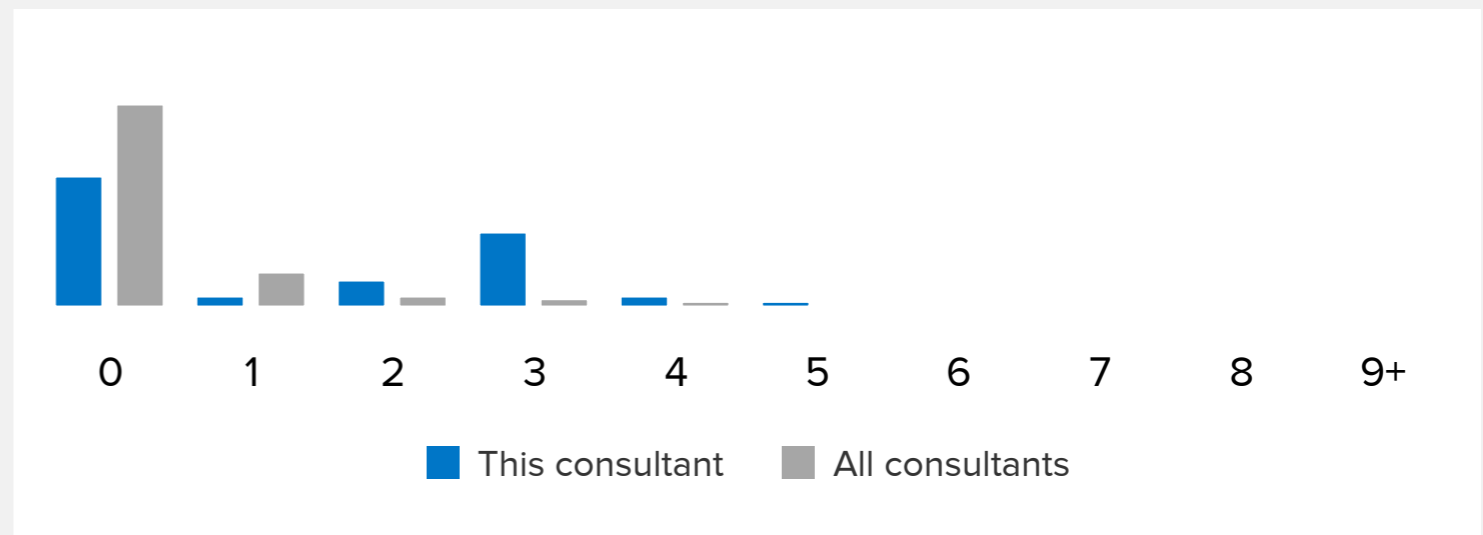
This measure shows how many procedures this consultant performs over a twelve month period. If the consultant has included their NHS patients the number is likely to be significantly higher than those including private patients only. The number of patients treated is not on its own an indicator of quality. However, The Royal College of Surgeons recommends that you ask your consultant whether they perform any proposed procedure



routinely.

### Length of stay

This measure provides a guide to the typical length of time a patient will spend in hospital for a specific procedure. Some procedures may be shown as day case – this means that you will not stay in hospital overnight. Others will show a longer recovery time. The length of stay for procedures will vary for a number of reasons, such as the time when surgery is scheduled. It is important that your stay is right for you. If you have queries or concerns you should discuss this with your consultant during your consultation.
